Entry information for the 2023 County Fair

ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED BY JULY 27.

- Entry fee \$2.00 per animal. Registering on-line -- you will be required to pay your entry fees when you pick up your entry tags in the Fair Office (Building B) or enclose check when mailing entry.
- 4-H members may exhibit 4-H Sheep in open class, pre-registration required by July 27, entry fee \$2.00 per animal.
- The entry fee entitles the animal to be shown in all individual and group lots to which it is eligible.
- Scrapies ID requirements see Health Rules.
- Sheep are not required to have health certificates but will be inspected by the Fair Veterinarian.
- Base date for computing age: January 1.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**
- Only one entry per lot.
- Animals will be shown by breed.
- If necessary due to crowding, the number of animals may be limited.

Showtime for judging – immediately following the 4-H show on Thursday, August 3. 4-H show begins at 3:00 PM.

Sheep will only be accepted at the barn:

Tuesday, August 1, 6 - 8 PM

Wednesday, August 2, 9 AM - 4 PM

Sheep released Sunday, 7 PM

Exhibitors are expected to clean their pens out – push bedding out to aisle or designated area after 7 PM on Sunday.

GRAND CHAMPION and RESERVE CHAMPION any sheep - Ribbon only

HERDSMANSHIP AWARD - will be given to the best all-around Sheep herdsman during the fair. The award will be made to the exhibitor judged best in such things as cleanliness of his livestock, stalls, aisles, equipment, the exhibitor, showmanship and courtesy to everyone visiting the barns.
