Entry information for the 2024 County Fair

ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED BY JULY 25.

- Entry fee is \$3.00 per animal. Registering on-line – you will be required to pay your entry fees when you pick up your entry tags in the Fair Office (Building B) or enclose check when mailing entry.
- 4-H members may exhibit 4-H Pygmy and all other breed Goats in open class, pre-registration required by July 25, entry fee \$3.00 per animal.
- If necessary due to crowding, the number of animals may be limited for exhibitors.
- Exhibitors are not to walk or carry their animals south of their Exhibit Building. This is to avoid any unwelcome animal actions (biting, kicking, etc.) to fairgoers.

Goats will be accepted:

Wednesday, July 31, 4 - 8 PM
Thursday, August 1, 8 - 11 AM

Goats released Sunday, 7 PM

Exhibitors are expected to clean their pens out – push bedding out to aisle or designated area after 7 PM on Sunday.

Pick-up premium checks Sunday 7-8 PM or Monday 9 AM – 5 PM

- Base date for ages is July 31
- Health certificates or herd certification/accreditation certificates must be available for the Fair Veterinarian.
- Pygmy and all other breed classes not sanctioned
- A written authorization from the owner that the goat/goats are being leased must be included with registration.
- Only owner/leaser of the said goat may participate in performance classes.
- Substitutions within lots will be permitted.
- Animals shown in Division Y, Classes 1 and 2 cannot be shown in Division D
- Each exhibitor or farm may have more than 2 entries per lot, but premiums will only be paid on 2 animals or groups per lot per exhibitor or farm.
- All exhibits must stay in place until 7 PM – **NO EXCEPTIONS**

1. Jr. Doe Kid 0 - 4 mos. (April 1, 2024 - present)
2. Sr. Doe Kid 5 - 7 mos. (Jan 1 - March 31, 2024)
3. Jr. Yearling 8 - 12 mos. (Aug 1 - Dec 31, 2023) if they have not had kids
4. Sr. Yearling 12 - 24mos. (Aug 1, 2022 - July 31, 2023) if they have not had kids

5. Jr. Get of Sire (3 does from same sire)
6. Does under 2 yrs. who have had kids

8. Does 3 & under 4 yrs. (Aug 2, 2020 - Aug 1, 2021)
9. Does 4 & under 5 yrs. (Aug 2, 2019 - Aug. 1, 2020)
10. Does over 5 yrs. (Aug 1, 2019 and before)

CLASS 3 — DRIVING GOATS

- Judged on manners, way of going, appropriateness of harness and vehicle, cleanliness of animal and driver.
- Single or double hitch

1. Doe/Wether, any age over 25 inches at withers
2. Doe/Wether, any age under 25 inches at withers

CLASS 4 — COSTUME GOATS

- Judged on costume originality, theme, neatness, willingness to be led by exhibitor around the ring with ease.
- Both goat and exhibitor to be in costume
- Doe/Wether any age

Lot below Premium Code D

1. Exhibitors Age 13 & over.
2. Exhibitors Age 6 to 12.
3. Exhibitors Age under 6 with an adult.

CLASS 5 — GOAT AGILITY

- Judged on manners, willingness to be led over an obstacle course.
- This event is timed.
- No pack required.

Lots below Premium Code C

1. Doe/Wether, any age, over 25 inches.
2. Doe/Wether, any age, under 25 inches.

HERDSMANSHIP AWARD - will be given to the best all-around Goat herdsman during the fair. The award will be made to the exhibitor judged best in such things as cleanliness of his livestock, stalls, aisles, equipment, the exhibitor, showmanship and courtesy to everyone visiting the barns.
