Entry information for 2026 County Fair

ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED BY JULY 23.

- Entry fee is \$3.00 per animal. Registering on-line – you will be required to pay your entry fees when you pick up your entry tags in the Fair Office (Building B) or enclose a check when mailing entry.
- 4-H members may exhibit 4-H Dairy in open class pre-registration required by July 23, entry fee is \$3.00 per animal.
- If necessary due to crowding, the number of animals may be limited for non-county exhibitors.
- Health rules must be met by all exhibitors.
- More than 1 entry per lot allowed, but premiums will only be paid for 2 highest placings in lot.
- Exhibitors are not to walk or carry their animals south of their Exhibit Building. This is to avoid any unwelcome animal actions (biting, kicking, etc.) to fairgoers.

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

Animals will be accepted Thursday, July 30, 8:00 - 11:00 AM.

Animals will be released Sunday, 7:00 PM.

Exhibitors are expected to clean their stall area and place bedding in outside bunker after 7 PM on Sunday.

Pick-up premium checks Sunday 8 - 9 PM or Monday 9 AM – 5 PM

5. Summer Yearling Heifer - June 1 - Aug 31, 2025
6. Jr. Yearling Heifer - March 1 - May 31, 2025

9. Jr. Best 3 Females - bred and owned by exhibitor, to consist of 3 animals under 2 years of age, none of which have freshened. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry.

10. Unfresh 2 yr. old - March 1 - Aug 31, 2024
11. Jr. 2 yr old in milk - March 1 - Aug 31, 2024
12. Sr. 2 yr old in milk - Sept 1, 2023 - Feb 29, 2024
13. Jr. 3 yr. old in milk - March 1 - Aug 31, 2023
14. Sr. 3 yr old in milk - Sept 1, 2022 - Feb 28, 2023
15. 4 yr old in milk - Sept 1, 2021 - Aug 31, 2022
16. 5 yr old in milk - Sept 1, 2020 - Aug 31, 2021
17. Aged cow in milk - before September 1, 2020
18. 100,000 lb. cow - lifetime production must be verified by a statement from exhibitors local testing supervisor or state extension office. The statement must accompany the animal to the show. Only DHIA or official milk production records will be accepted. Cows entered in this class will not be eligible to show in the aged cow class.
19. Dry Cow, 3 and 4 year old - Sept 1, 2021 - Aug 31, 2023
20. Dry Aged Cow - before Sept 1, 2020
21. Dairy Herd - to consist of 3 females that have freshened, all to be owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to 1 entry in this lot.

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22. 3 Best Females - 3 females, any age, all bred and at least 1 owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to 1 entry in this lot.
23. Produce of Dam - to consist of 2 animals, any age, either sex, the produce of 1 cow. The dam must be named. Animals need not be owned by the same exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to 1 entry from the same dam.
24. Daughter and Dam

HERDSMANSHIP AWARD will be given to the best all-around Dairy herdsman during the fair. The award will be made to the exhibitor judged best in such things as cleanliness of his livestock, stalls, aisles, equipment, the exhibitor, showmanship and courtesy to everyone visiting the barns.
