- The age of the exhibitor **MUST** appear on the entry tag of all Class A entries.
- Only 1 entry per lot.
- Soiled articles will not be judged.
- Articles which have previously won a premium are not eligible.
- Any article having exhibitor's name displayed must have it securely covered by stitched cloth, tape, etc. for entry day and judging. Building staff **WILL NOT** complete this task for exhibitors. Covers will be removed after judging for public viewing.
- The department cannot be held responsible for loss or breakage of exhibits.
- **Kit items will not be eligible for Grand or Reserve Champion awards.**
