### Entry information for the 2022 County Fair

#### ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED BY JULY 28

- Entry fee \$0.50 per bird. Registering on-line – you will be required to pay your entry fees when you pick up your entry tags in the Fair Office (Building B) or enclose check when mailing in entry.
- 4-H members may exhibit 4-H Poultry in open class, pre-registration required by July 28, entry fee \$0.50 per bird.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**
- **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER LOT PER BREED**
- ALL BIRDS MUST HAVE A LEGAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE. All birds MUST BE IDENTIFIED by numbered leg band. (Bands available for purchase at check-in).
- Birds shown in single classes ARE NOT ELIGIBLE to form part of a trio.
- Classes will be divided according to breed.
- LIST BREED AND VARIETY on entry blank.
- Exhibitors need not be present for judging.
- Care for your own birds. Water and shavings provided. EXHIBITORS FURNISH OWN FEED
- **NO TESTING OF BIRDS AT THE FAIR**
- All birds will be judged using the American Standard of Perfection as a guide.

Tuesday, August 2, 1 - 9 PM

Wednesday, August 3, 8 - 9:30 AM

Birds released 8 PM Sunday, August 8. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

**Exhibitors are expected to clean each cage out and put in dump trailer on west side of barn after 8 PM on Sunday. Disassemble and stack cages on pallets.**

Pick-up premium checks Sunday 8 - 9 PM or Monday 9 AM – 5 PM
