### 2021 MINIATURE HORSE SHOW CLASS LIST

Entry Fee: \$4.00 per class, \$5.00 office charge.

One number per horse, the number will follow the horse.

First place trophy and six ribbons in each class.

Payback to four places in each class: \$10, \$8, \$6, \$4.

- ~ *A Miniature Horse is defined as any horse 38" or smaller at the last hairs of the Mane. They do NOT need to be registered to attend the show.*
- ~ *Negative Coggins paperwork required*
- ~ *Youth are for ages 17 and under as of January 1<sup>st</sup>. Adults are 18 and over.*
- ~ *Horses CANNOT cross enter driving classes. Pick a driving style that best suits your horse. If you are not sure, ask someone and they will help you.*
- ~ *Patterns will be posted on FB page "Washington County Fair Miniature Horse Show" and posted at the show.*
- ~ *If it rains, show will be held indoors and all driving classes and liberty will be cancelled.*
- ~ *Horses must stay north of the barns.*
- ~ *All Horse trailers use County Road 14 Entrance*

4. Over 3 years old Mares - Halter
5. **Champion Jr. Horse – Halter (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place come back from class 1 and 2)**
6. **Champion Sr. Horse – Halter (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place come back from class 3 and 4)**
7. Solid Color (your horse is judged only on its color)
8. Multi-Color (your horse is judged only on its multi-color)
9. Open Most Beautiful Eyes Horse
10. Youth Halter - Gelding or Mare
11. Youth 10 and under - Showmanship Mare or Gelding (quarters system)
12. Youth 11 – 17 Showmanship (quarters system)
13. Adult Showmanship (quarters system)
14. Open Book Hat Showmanship (Bring your own hard covered book or use ours. Simple SMS pattern, no western hat, you balance a book on your head, minus a point every time your book falls off)
15. Lead line (must have a saddle)
16. Youth Hunter (slow and pretty)

17. Adult Hunter (slow and pretty)
18. Youth Jumper (first round don't knock, final round timed)
19. Adult Jumper (first round don't knock, final round timed)

20. Open Costume class
21. Open Barrel and Egg race (lead horse with egg on spoon and run around barrel)
22. Open Bat race (lead horse down to a baseball bat, put forehead on bat and spin 10 circles in one direction, run horse back down)
23. Open Ribbon race (Partner up with a friend, 2 minis, 2 people holding a paper ribbon and don't break the ribbon while you try to get around a barrel together)
24. Open Bribe-A-Horse (bring a bucket of your horse's favorite treats, remove the halter and go for a fast run)
25. Open Liberty (bring your music to match your horses gaits and show them off for 1.5 minutes. 2 minutes to catch your horse – no baiting and bring a friend in the arena with you to help)
26. Youth Halter - Obstacle
27. Adult Halter - Obstacle
28. Open Obstacle Driving
29. Youth Western Country Pleasure Driving (this is for horses with a more level headset and have a long sweeping leg)
30. Adult Western Country Pleasure Driving (this is for horses with a more level headset and have a long sweeping leg)
31. Youth Country Pleasure Driving (this is for horses with a little more upright head and more knee action)
32. Adult Country Pleasure Driving (this is for horses with a little more upright head and more knee action)
33. Youth Open Pleasure Driving (this is for the highest headed horse with more leg animation including hocks)
34. Adult Pleasure Driving (this is for the highest headed horse with more leg animation including hocks)
35. Open Reinsmanship (pattern class)
